

CYSA Coach Code of Conduct

As a CYSA Coach, I will:

- 1) create a fun, positive atmosphere for my players and opposing teams.
- 2) treat all players fairly and with respect and set the highest standard for others to follow.
- 3) never place the value of winning over the safety of players.
- 4) instruct players to play within the written laws of the game and within the spirit of the game.
- 5) be a positive role model, show emotional maturity by controlling my anger, and never use obscene language or gestures.
- 6) confine myself to the coaching area during games.
- 7) respect and abide by the referee's decisions during the game and refrain from criticizing officials in the presence of players.
- 8) not incite players or spectators or attempt to disrupt the flow of play.
- 9) encourage spectators to refrain from demonstrating intimidating behavior towards officials or opposing teams.
- 10) address comments regarding officials in writing to the CYSA VP of Officials.

I have read and agree to follow the Coach Code of Conduct at all league activities. I understand that if I do not follow these guidelines, I may be asked to leave the league activity and/or give up my CYSA position of coach.
